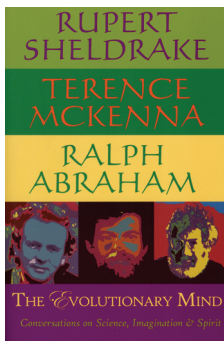

A fascinating read, this book first was published in 1998 as *The Evolutionary Mind: Trialogues at the Edge of the Unthinkable*. The revised and updated 2005 version contains two new trialogues with the eminent authors. Biologist Rupert Sheldrake introduced morphic resonance theory. His numerous writings include *The Sense of Being Stared At* and *A New Science of Life*. The late Terence McKenna, best known as a psychedelic shaman and time theorist, wrote *Food of the Gods* and *True Hallucinations*. Ralph Abraham is a chaos mathematician who wrote *Chaos, Gaia*, and several other books.

The notable triumvir eloquently discusses theories that simultaneously are scientific, philosophical, spiritual, and original. Topics covered include evolution and the morphogenetic field of our entire ecosystem; unsolved mysteries of psychic pets and homing pigeons; fractals; collective consciousness; the evolutionary emergence of the human mind; and psychedelic and mathematical visions as the basis of computer innovations. Each topic is introduced by one author and then discussed in dialogue format.

The power and vibrancy of *The Evolutionary Mind* are reflected in its multicolored, psychedelic cover. I recommend this book to all intellectual, freethinking people.
